HUMANE MARIIAGE HIGHLIGHTS

- There were 40 stalls , Handicrafts by Handicapped specially erected by Nirmal inside the marriage hall .
- The marriage band was rendered by
 DIFFERENTLY-ABLED CHILDREN
- Those who came to bless the marriage couple went via the Handicrafts by Handicapped STALLS . The marriage invitees bought Rs 2. 5 lakhs worth handicraft-goods (to give as present to the newly weds as well as for their own use)
- The surplus cooked food was taken over to slums and food was distributed .

- Handicrafts by Handicapped STALLS had a sales turnover of over 2.5 lakhs

- Dress was bought and provided to 72 Handicrafts by Handicapped , differently-abled stall-keepers.

Specially made food plus surplus cooked food was taken over to nearby slums and food was served to the poor via FOOD-BRIDGE an ExNoRa organisation .
